LANIVET DEFIBRILLATOR INFORMATION

IN CASE OF A CARDIAC ARREST

There are **TWO** defibrillators in the village



 Lanivet One For All Community Centre

(situated in the outside entrance porch to the Centre)

Simply twist the outside casing anti clockwise in the direction of the arrows and the outer casing will come off giving you access to the Defibrillator.



2. Mid Cornwall Brokers Ltd

(situated on the outside wall of the building on Truro Road)

You will need to call 999, and give Ambulance Control the CABINET NUMBER which is CC0099. They will give you a code to put into the keypad which will open the box giving you access to the Defibrillator.

NOTE: The One for All Community Centre are planning more free defibrillator awareness sessions in the near future.

We sometimes hear a remark about corruption; usually in relation to the police: 'It's just a few rotten apples', we are told. Bad people find their way into an institution and commit crimes.

The challenge faced by the police and all sorts of other organisations is that the metaphor of rotting apples is more sinister than the impact of a few individuals. There is a scientific basis to agree that a rotten apple spoils the whole barrel. Apparently the agricultural challenge has to do with ethylene; a gas produced internally by the fruit to stimulate ripening. Ethylene is a plant hormone. It sets in motion a number of processes that are responsible for ripening. Rotting is just the end stage of ripening, with more and more ethylene being released into the surrounding air. This stimulates the ripening of nearby fruit, setting off sort of a chain reaction that results in the spoilage of the whole barrel.

In relation to organisations, this means that the rotten apple metaphor could describe accurately the slow corruption of all involved. With the increasing influence of the corrupt, the ordinary member of the organisation is exposed to anti-social attitudes. The organisation itself is in danger of becoming anti-social because its culture has become so.

I worry that this happens in wider society. If we allow corrupting attitudes to linger amongst us, we too are in danger of becoming corrupted. The national 'barrel of apples' may decay as a whole.

Jesus spoke boldly against corruption. The church has been known for doing the same even as it too succumbs to decay from time to time. We would do well to notice the whiff of corruption amongst us and call it out. Otherwise, the rot will spread

GARDEN JOTTINGS

Well it doesn't need me to tell you all that we've had a dreadful two months start this year regarding the weather. For gardeners and especially our farmers it's been quite catastrophic. Incessant rain throughout February has almost been a record for Cornwall. If you weren't aware, it was the fourth wettest February on record. On top of that it has been the warmest start to a New Year on record. That means we haven't really had a cold spell to kill off all those bugs etc which may devastate our flower beds later in the year. Frost also helps break up the soil allowing important oxygen into air spaces lower down in the subsoil. All in all not impressed! Although my father, who always took a differing view of most things would say, "At least you're alive to see it!!".

All I can advise currently for the garden is to keep off walking over any of it until the ground has dried out substantially. There is little to gain in creating solid masses of topsoil which will not be able to hold nutrients or further watering throughout the summer season. If you haven't been able to get out into your garden, try and manage a little bit as a final tidying up will not go amiss. With all the damp, mild weather slugs have found their heaven where to eat their way through new shoots as they come to the surface.

As I write this our lane has been filled with the native primrose, primula vulgaris all starting to show their faces. They really are one of my all-time favourites. If you are an afternoon TV viewer, then do try and catch a brand-new series on ITV3 at 2.00pm called Alan Titchmarsh's Garden Club. First impressions, it's very good and contains lots of information and ideas for the budding gardener. Meanwhile the camellias are already showing their flowers, unfortunately some have been caught by the strong winds and heavy rain beating down on them. The ground surrounding the bushes are a carpet of colour. I hope the late frosts hold off and gives them all a chance. The Magnolia *stellata* is full of buds and ready to break, in fact I've never seen so many for a long time.

If the weather remains mild I'm going to try a fence of sweet peas. I used to grow them years ago but now I feel like trying again. It's too late for growing them from pots but you should be able to get away with planting seed directly into the open ground. They'll soon strike and when they have made about 10" pinch out the tops to ensure they branch out. Water regularly and you should have a lovely show and have flowers for inside the house as a bonus.

My final mantra being, please do not forget the birds with seed and water both are essential this time of year when they are breeding.

Councillor Jenny Cruse

Yesterday I spent the day going around my ward looking at all the flooding. It was truly scary and the amount of water cascading from the fields onto the highways was quite unbelievable. The flood at Jims on the A389 was particularly worrying since I had reported blocked drains and a flood there a week ago and there was no flood



warning in place. All reported again. The road to Nanstallon from Jims was like a war zone and the water was torrential coming down Old Coach Road into Lamorick, it had even lifted the tarmac higher up the hill. It is quite clear that we must address these problems and I have compiled a list of priorities that must be dealt with as it is evident that we will continue to experience extreme wet winters. After the visits I sent my photos to the Service Director, Portfolio Holder and Scott Mann. Scott has already written to the Council to remind them that the extra funding they are receiving for potholes must be ringfenced and must be used for road maintenance.

I know that many of my residents in Lanivet are concerned about the unsatisfactory state of the River Camel and the extra load taken on by Nanstallon WwTW. Earlier this month I attended two Bodmin Town Council planning meetings where the planning application for Halgavor Moor was discussed. The meetings were very well attended by the public and my full report can be read on my Facebook page / jennytostand. This application has been contested since the land was allocated which was over 10 years ago. Since my election I have been working in the background to make clear the concerns of my residents. This valuable unimproved land is a wildlife haven and home to some of our most threatened wildlife and flora species, it is the lungs of Bodmin and is a communal green space where residents can walk and enjoy nature. But very importantly it is a moor with areas of boggy land and includes in the southwest area a flood plain 3. Numerous springs feed into the tributary and run off from the A30. Anyone living close to Bodmin knows about springs and aquafer. I support the objections of Bodmin Town Council and I would make it clear that we have a duty to ensure that no houses are built where the residents may have to suffer the heartbreak of flooding in their homes and gardens. Spring is just around the corner, the daffodils and crocus are out, the birds are twittering away in the trees and today we saw some warming sunshine which lifted the spirits. It has been a long difficult winter and we all deserve some sunny dry days....I am sure they will come.


