

Simply twist the outside casing anti clockwise in the direction of the arrows and the outer casing will come off giving you access to the Defibrillator.

The new Bishop of Truro, David Williams, will be welcomed to his cathedral in Truro on 17th May. It will be a grand affair, resplendent with well wishers from all sections of Cornish life. The carefully choreographed service confirms his responsibilities for the life of this diocese and enshrines his role as a servant of its people. He will spend hours shaking people's hands after the service and chatting with all sorts. Cornwall has the most amazing Christian history, from the arrival of St. Piran, St. Guron and St. Petroc in the 6th Century. Some people argue it has the longest undiscurted

and St. Petroc in the 6th Century. Some people argue it has the longest undisrupted Christian tradition in the British Isles. The Saxon invasions did not reach this far so monasteries were able to continue serving and teaching their people without being cast out from their dwellings and lands. Our villages and towns still have signs of this ancient heritage. We continue to honour this Celtic faith in our more recent Medieval buildings.

Bishop David is all too aware of this great tradition. It is his role to preserve and continue it. In particular he has to articulate the faith of our ancestors in this generation, speaking in contemporary and relevant terms about the gospel of Christ in today's world. He will want to listen before he says too much. That is always the first job of a new spiritual leader. Unless he understands the lives of the people he lives amongst he is likely to misread what is happening and utter words that don't quite fit. We should give him time and await his response to what he observes and hears. Bishop David's first visit to the Bodmin Team Ministry was on the day his appointment was announced by Downing Street. He met up with Revd Elaine Munday at one of her community activities and then went to say Evensong at St. Meubred's, Cardinham. He will be presiding at a team service in St. Petroc's on the 21st September. I am sure he will be a frequent visitor to our part of Cornwall. I will alert you to those times when he will be around in the hope you might like to meet him and offer him your wisdom on the situations we face around us. In the meantime, he has assured me of his support for our various ventures and looks forward to sharing in the life of our churches.

GARDEN JOTTINGS

The weather has been guite changeable these past few months and Easter has already come and gone. I usually mention the weather in my jottings and this month is certainly no exception. Well, it may come as no surprise to learn that Cornwall was the wettest county in the UK for the entire month of April. It received 169% above the monthly average. In doing so it also suffered the highest recorded rain in a day – namely 33.22 mm. It was also recorded to be the warmest April in the UK for the month. Our farmers have suffered and so have our gardens apart from the fact that hard frosts were kept at bay. Currently blossom appears to be everywhere. The early spring flowers have been and gone: the bluebells have given their heart. If you love them as I do then when the seed pod is ripe, and the pods dry out sprinkle them around and you will soon expand your display of these lovely spring flowers. I have a lovely display in the garden of fantastic acers ranging in colour from bright red, yellow and light green. Do consider these varieties for wonderful colour in your garden, they are so easy to maintain and require little maintenance. June is certainly the month for planting up your hanging baskets, if you're planning on DIY then purchase sturdy, vibrant plants with plenty of colour including evergreens. Use a good compost that is pre-mixed for hanging baskets. These tend to help the compost not dry out so quick given our warmer summers. Seek advice via 'YouTube' for tips on the subject. Of course, you can always go to one of our local garden centres that make them to order to fulfil your requirements. As we have been very short of water lately everything requires a good watering, including currently my bluebells! Obviously, anything in pots should regularly require a good soaking in these dry long spells. Meanwhile the year marches on, please don't forget to maintain a regime of deadheading your summer bedding. This will ensure continuous flowering throughout the summer.





Whilst the Council did not arrange formal celebrations many celebrated this event in their own way. Bodmin held events that many were able to attend.

Local Elections for Lanivet Parish Council

Ten of our original councillors were re-appointed without challenge. Two others were unable to complete the copious forms in time so have applied to be co-opted. This is a much easier way to apply to sit on the council and I am pleased two others have likewise applied to be co-opted. Appointments will be made on the 15 May when the council meets in Nanstallon.

Cornwall Councillors

We say to Chris Batters "welcome back" as we say "adieu" to Jenny Cruse and thank her for her support over the last 4 years. In my time as Chairman we have been blessed with Cornwall Councillors who do their best to be active in the community and try to help us when it comes to needing support from the unitary authority.

New Building for Under 5s in Lanivet

It is encouraging to see the continuing progress of the new building.

Suffice to say that Jessica and her team continue to explore every avenue for further funding. If you feel you are able to help please contact the parish clerk.

Lanivet Car Park

We continue to work with Cornwall Legal Services to secure ownership of the Lanivet Green and car park.

Parish Budget for 2025-26

I have been asked to summarise the reasons for the £22,500 (36.9%) increase in the Lanivet precept. Firstly, as at 31st March 2025 the total funds stood at just over £48,000 which is lower than two years ago yet our costs continue to increase each year. Secondly, in the last 3 years we have committed some £100,000 to local projects, often making up for what Cornwall Council has failed to do. In addition, we are facing the challenge of finding £150,000 to replace all the play equipment on the Lanivet Green and create a permeable base so that children don't play in mud. We will achieve this by building up our reserves. We also want to help maintain the facilities we have supported in such a way that price does not deter the very people who need them most. We are also having to maintain more of the local pathways as Cornwall Council reduces its support. We will need to continually review our reserves to ensure that we are able to maintain the whole estate for you and following generations and not allow the parish to deteriorate beyond repair.



I must mention this was just after our 'friend' Donald Trump caused absolute chaos in the financial and energy markets by introducing tariffs everywhere and I might just have got lucky, but this was a huge difference and every time I have ordered oil previously, the prices have varied slightly between providers.
