GRASS CUTTING CONTRACT 2024-25 - Rolling

You are invited to submit a fixed price tender for grass cutting/grounds maintenance as indicated in the schedule below, for a period of one years, rolling forward annually if both parties agree new terms.

The contract will commence on the 1st April 2024.

All areas shall be cut and left tidy in a workman like manner to the approval of the Parish Council and in accordance with the following schedule. All cuttings, debris, pruning's, etc. shall be removed from site and disposed of by the Contractor on the day that the work is carried out. The use of mulching mowing machines will be acceptable on the larger grass areas at the discretion of the Parish Council. Areas around wood and metal structures, fences, play equipment etc. trees and areas of gravel pathway are to be treated with a suitable herbicide to save damage from mechanical cutting equipment.

Contractors shall be responsible for providing suitable machinery and equipment for each task they undertake and that the maintenance and safety procedures are carried out for the safe use of that machinery and equipment. All Contractors shall provide proof that they are in possession of Public Liability Insurance and any certification that is required for the task they are undertaking and that they have made the required risk assessments associated with each task.

Note!!

All areas are to be priced separately, as the Parish Council reserves the right to appoint different contractors to each area and remove any area from the schedule at any time. All tenders must contain the total price, for each area, for the year 2024-25 and be broken down into price per cut, as the council may require extra cuts over and above the schedule

The Parish Council also reserves the right to terminate any contract, after 30 days notice, should any work not be carried out to the Parish Council's satisfaction.

Area 1 Not shown on map

THE NEW CEMETERY

Cutting the area around and between the existing graves and the perimeter of that part of the land used for graves also the pathways to and from the gates to the graves. To be cut once a month (the same week each month) if required from the 1st April for a total of 7 cuts. Weed Spraying as required.

In addition advise on and address any unwanted growth near and on the walls surrounding the cemetery.

*(**Excluded** : Cutting the areas not yet used for burials and any areas not in area 1 above.)*

Area 3

THE OLD CEMETERY Marked Mauve on map

Cutting the whole area of the Cemetery and trimming the hedges on Rectory Road and along the path to the green to maintain the width and height. In addition addressing any unwanted growth on the other two walls surrounding the cemetery.

Grass to be cut 3 times a year, end of May, July and October and any other time either requested by the Parish Council or if advised by the Contractor and approved by the Parish Council. Hedges to be trimmed as necessary and when appropriate. The Parish Council to be informed prior to any hedge trimming taking place.

In addition to advise on and treat any weed, in particular Japanese Knotweed..

Area 4a

THE VILLAGE GREEN Marked Green on map

Cutting to the perimeter of the Village Green and both sides of the stream down to the water's edge, the area between the stream and Church Road along the whole of its length, the area around the play equipment up to the path also the area at the rear of Mid Cornwall Brokers and around the toilets, car park and bus shelter. Also the path between the School and

the Old Cemetery. To be cut approximately every 28 days from the 1st April to November and then the following March for a total of 9 cuts.
